In mid-April 2005 the Santa Clarita Valley is switching from chlorine to chloramines for drinking water.

That means you must switch your tank and pond filters, tablets or drops to neutralize chloramines.

It's a simple, but necessary switch to protect your aquatic pet.

Chloramines are SAFE to drink for people, dogs, cats and all other NON-aquatic animals. By converting to chloramines, Castaic Lake Water Agency will comply with more stringent U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulatory standards.
